

Double Delight

You will need:

Pergamano Perforating/Embossing diagonal grid

Embossing tools ball tools various sizes

Perforating tool 1-needle

Pergamano Hockey stick

Pergamano Perga Liner

Parchment scissors

Tracing: the whole design with white pencil.

Emboss/Perforate with Diagonal grid: on back with embossing tool small ball: emboss according to grid pattern.. on front With 1-needle tool perforate according to grid.

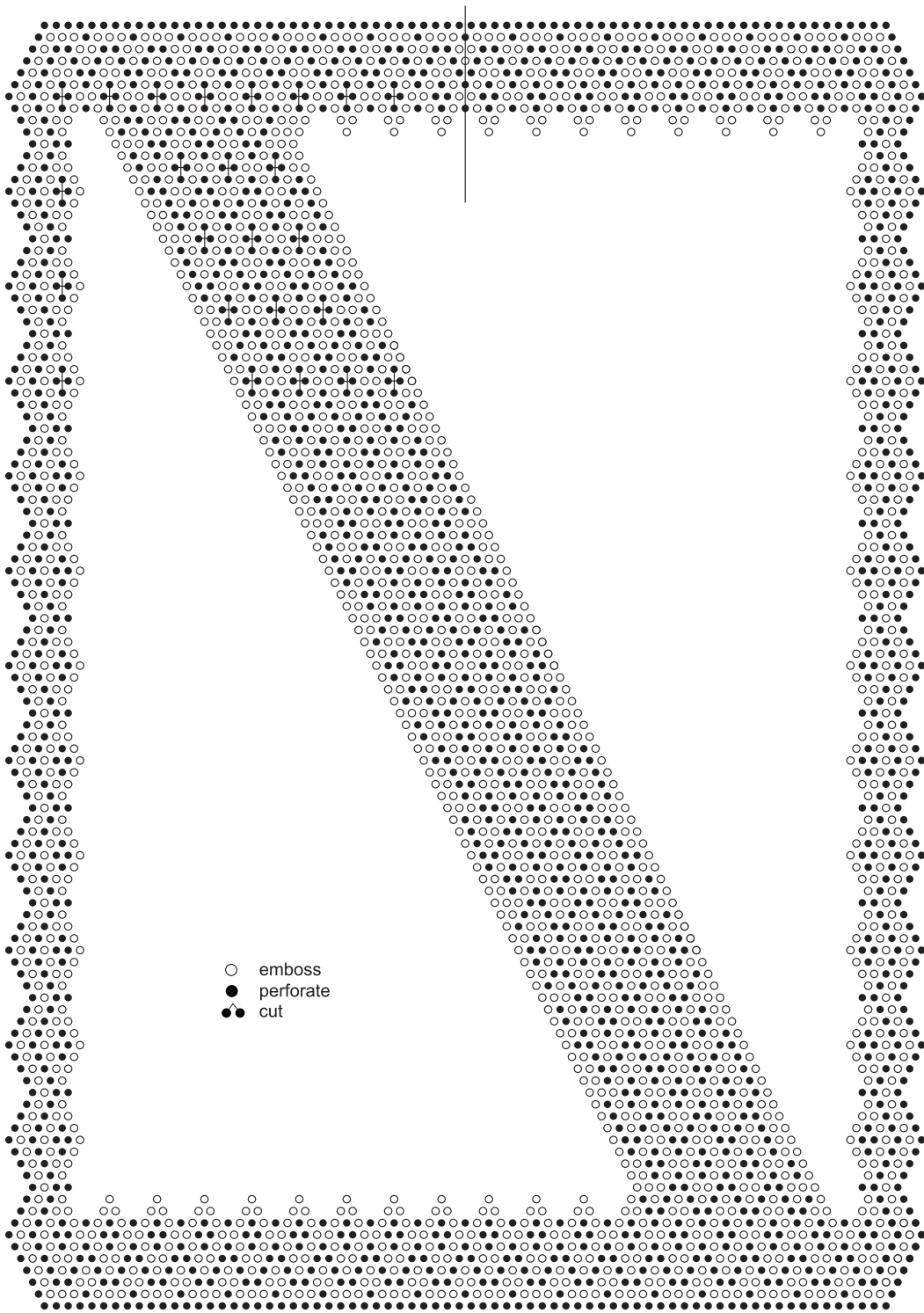
Note: the pattern appears reversed. It is because you need to start embossing dots before perforating which means you are working from the back side of project. When you turn project over for perforating, the front side reveals the correct result.

Painting: with perga liner A1 (white) and brush no.2: basecoat all petals. A4 (blue): in shadow areas as shown in the colored photo. Use fine lines to achieve delicate effect.

Embossing: with hockey stick: white painted area only.

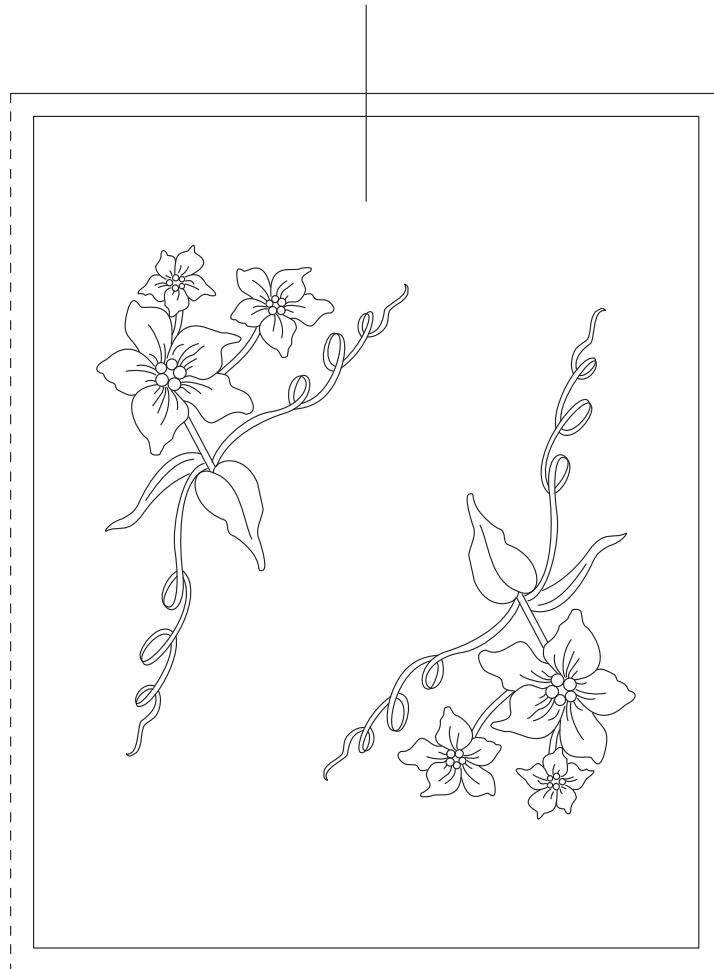
Cutting: with parchment scissors according to cut pattern.

Finishing: attach to a dark blue card stock using dab of glue
